Purposes of the processing of your personal data

The Agency processes your personal data for the following purpose:

Categories of personal data

Storage of your personal data

The information that the Agency is required to register in its records is transferred on an ongoing basis to the Danish National Archives in accordance with the rules of the Archives Act and the provisions of the Danish National Archives. Information that we receive and that is not covered by the Agency's obligation to register records will be deleted when we no longer need it.

Your rights

Under the General Data Protection Regulation, you have a number of rights in relation to our processing of information about you. If you wish to exercise your rights, please contact us.

Right of access

You have the right to access the information about you that we process (right of access), or to apply for access to documents.

Right to rectification

You have the right to have incorrect information about yourself corrected.

Right to erasure

In special cases, you have the right to have information about you deleted before the time of our ordinary general deletion. This only applies to information that is not subject to record-keeping obligations.
